The sauce looks to have a lot of honey in it based on its consistency but one small sniff let's you know it's going to have plenty of kick! The smell is pure pepper and spices!

Product Appearance - 3

The look of the sauce/3 points possible

Great looking sauce! It looks and pours like honey...it's loaded with spices though and you see them easily in its amber color.

Packaging - 2

The appearance of the bottle and label/2 points possible

The packaging here is simply awesome. The graphics are colorful and fun. I also like the fact how descriptive the labeling is...not only do you get the name of "Honey Hot" they further clarify by labeling it as "sweet and spicy with medium bite" giving you a really good idea of what your getting even before you buy this product.
